National Right to Life Committee is the nation's oldest and largest pro-life organization and is the parent organization to Nebraska Right to Life. National Right to Life Committee President Carol Tobias, a native of North Dakota, has served on the National Right to Life board of directors since 1987. From 1983 to 1991, she was executive director of North Dakota Right to Life and in 1991 was hired as National Right to Life political director, a position she held until 2005. During her tenure as political director, pro-life majorities were elected to both the U.S. House of Representatives and U.S. Senate. In both 2000 and 2004, she oversaw the efforts of National Right to Life's political action committee on behalf of George W. Bush.

The Nebraska Walk for Life is an event sponsored by Nebraska Right to Life since 1974. It has become the largest First Amendment demonstration in the state, bringing 3,000 to 5,000 pro-lifers from across Nebraska to march in solidarity against Roe v. Wade and in support of women and teens facing unplanned pregnancies.

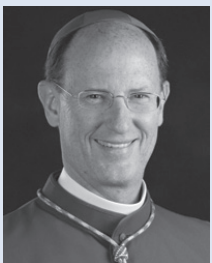
