Introducing the Lincoln Right to Life Pro-Life Center

Hello Pro-Life Lincoln!

I have a great announcement to share with you.

Lincoln Right to Life is leasing the property across the street from Planned Parenthood, 5632 S. 48th St., Lincoln, Nebraska. Effective February 1, 2018, this 3,300-square-foot property, Lincoln Right to Life Pro-Life Center, will give us a base to support the prayerful presence we maintain. This property is in direct line of sight of the Planned Parenthood facility. We will have up to five parking spots for prayer warriors and activities in the new space. This property will serve as a beacon of hope to women who find no hope as they walk into Planned Parenthood.

My goal is that it will also serve as beacon of unity for the pro-life community. We will have signage to educate the uninformed, console the wounded and inspire the dormant within the community. As I have mentioned previously, this remains primarily a spiritual battle, and we are the warriors to fight on the side of life.

I am calling on each of you to utilize the momentum of this great new location to join our battle. We could use your assistance in the following ways:

Prayer Warriors

Sign up for an hour a week to be present throughout the year. If schedules do not permit, find a small group to fill that hour throughout the year.

Workers

We have work to do to prepare the property to get it to the peaceful, prayerful and educational space we wish to foster. If you have time or talent in this area, please contact Mike Davis, 402-480-0404, for the latest need.

This is a large financial responsibility we are undertaking. We take our fiduciary responsibilities very seriously. Through your past generosity, we are in position to take advantage of this great opportunity. But in order to maintain this financial strength, we need your continued support. As we enter this exciting new chapter in Lincoln Right to Life's history, I am asking you to consider a renewed pro-life

activity in 2018. I recommend the following for your consideration:

1. Read the book "40 Days for Life," sign it and pass it along to someone else who will read and pass it along. Books are no cost to you and available from Mike Davis or on the table at the Lincoln Right to Life Pro-Life Center.
2. Sign up for one hour per week in the 40 Days for Life spring campaign and invite a friend.
3. Take 15 minutes a day to offer up your prayers for the specific intention of those lost and wounded by abortion.
4. Take the value of a dinner out and make a donation to LRTL for the pro-life work to continue.
5. Come visit the new Lincoln Right to Life Pro Life Center, take a tour and attend an upcoming event.
6. Come on Tuesday to experience the reality of an abortion Tuesday. Praying while watching the women walk in as mothers, and walk out post abortive is heartbreaking. Your presence there is critical for the one woman who wants to change her mind but does not have a pro-life voice in her life at the time. You can be that presence.

Our activities will cover three primary areas, prayer and spiritual warfare, educational programs and outreach, and the focus on the women, counseling and support. If you have a special interest or idea for how we can share the pro-life message at the new facility, please let us know. There are more opportunities than ever to be involved in Lincoln Right to Life.
